BONAFIDE REASON was somewhat slow getting into stride, kept off the pace off the rail, lacked room entering the stretch then came from between horses near the eighth pole taking the lead and drawing clear under a healthy hand ride. FIT PERFORMER raced just off the pace, made a three wide bid rounding the turn, was bothered some entering the stretch then chased the winner to the wire. JOYEUX NOEL rated the pace, held onto a short lead inside to midstretch then weakened in the final sixteenth. MILADYS A PROSPECT stalked the pace, moved to a short lead on the turn, was tested entering the stretch, swerved out and weakened from the furlong pole. BEIN rated close to the pace, was five wide through the turn then had no stretch response. TALKIN TO AN ANGEL raced in the five path and offered no rally. PLACE KICKER, well off the pace, tended to get out through the stretch. MISS MALAGA was never a factor and bore out through the stretch.
