GANHARVA saved ground, launched a mild rally on the turn and dug in to save the place. PURE DESIRE rallied mildly three wide. MURPHY STYLE was outrun early, rallied four wide into the lane and flattened out late. THE BEER MISER raced off the pace and failed to respond. SAYHELLOWAVEGOODBY angled in for a clear run at the quarter pole and then lacked a rally. RATHER BEE GOOD set a pressured pace and gave way. HEY DOLL pressed the pace and faded.
