OUR CONCERTO vied outside, cleared off entering the turn and drew away under urging. STIMULUS PROGRAM was off a bit slow, advanced inside, came three wide into the stretch and rallied for second. SAMMY'S TRIP raced three wide, came four wide into the stretch and gained mildly outside. RUN THE LINE saved ground, raced in the two path on the turn and lacked a rally. OUR CORN was off a bit slow, vied inside and tired. INDIAN APPEAL raced between rivals and gave way.
