GET STORMY broke awkwardly and rated on the pace, showed the way to the lane then responded when asked to edge away. ROMAN TIGER saved ground and moved up inside into the far turn, came out under left handed pressure bothering a rival nearing the eighth pole then was clear for the place. KISS THE KID up close early, could not keep pace into the far turn then gained some late for the show award. PLEASANT STRIKE never far back, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn, was bumped nearing the eighth pole and weakened. INDIAN DANCE trailed while not far back, raced between rivals in the lane and lacked the needed rally. STAYING ON (IRE) a bit awkwardly leaving the gate, eased out and raced three wide on the backstretch while prompting the issue, chased and weakened in the drive. Following a stewards inquiry and a claim of foul by the rider of PLEASANT STRIKE against ROMAN TIGER for stretch interference, the latter was disqualified from second and placed fourth.
