Footnotes

SEEKING THE SILVER rated the pace in the four path, moved clear angling inward on the turn then maintained with steady pressure through the stretch. RITA'S THE ONE became briefly unsettled at the start, advanced to contention inside, angled outside the winner entering the stretch then couldn't get by. WALLOP rated close to the early pace, gave chase in the four path on the turn then leveled out in the drive. WILD TOGA NITES showed no speed, saved ground through the turn and offered no rally. ALERTING, unhurriedly in mid track, passed tiring rivals outside. CAITLINS GIRL showed no speed, saved ground through the turn then offered no rally. CHEZ AUDRA chased the pace from the outside, continued the chase five wide on the turn then faded in the drive. TAKEM AND LEAVEM chased the pace while five and six wide then tired.
