DANCING LION always a factor, bid three wide on the final turn and reached the front passing the eighth pole then proved best to the wire. AGENT COOPER prompted early, bid on the final turn and vied for command then continued on gamely to the end. PARTY HALO up close early near the rail, raced four wide turning for home and finished willingly. MACHO MO MON set the early pace, responded when headed on the final turn and battled into midstretch then weakened. IN GOD'S COUNTRY chased off the inside and gained some in the stretch. GOOSE BAY moved up inside nearing the half mile pole then lacked the needed stretch response while just a bit erratic briefly. ETTELSON lacked a rally.
