SECRET RIVER close up along the inside while being rated, finished willingly. LAURICA posted the early fractions, responded when asked on the final turn then weakened late. HIGH LADY lodged a bid outside on the last turn and offered a mild late gain. RUFF saved ground and advanced some into upper stretch then lacked the needed late response. COUSIN GIGI stalked the early pace, lodged a bid on the final turn and weakened in the drive. MINKIE never far back and between rivals into the far turn, came up empty when asked. DEVIL IN PINK raced forwardly placed to the far turn, gave way and lost contact in the stretch.
