MOOJI MOO rated close to the pace through the backstretch, was steadied six wide on the turn to avoid a loose rival, made her bid from the top of the stretch, moved to a short lead at the furlong pole then was carried out late while moving clear. SEMINOLE GAL was bothered by loose rival, GOTTA BE A STAR early on then raced unhurriedly through the backstretch, started her drive nearing the quarter pole, angled out into the stretch and continued her bid through the stretch to be clear in place. TALESPIN ran off the pace toward the outside, was widest through the turn and closed evenly through the stretch. HALLOWED, off the pace, was four wide on the turn then drifted out through the stretch. EDWARD'SFANCYPANTS was kept just off the pace, saved ground rounding the turn then finished evenly nearest the rail. NORTHERN ENERGY raced quickly clear to set the pace, was ridden apprehensively in close proximity to a loose rival nearing the quarter pole then leveled out while drifting outward through the stretch. CHANTEL D was outrun while saving ground. ELISHA'S GOLD showed no speed and was never in contention. GOTTA BE A STAR stumbled losing her rider at the start. A brief stewards inquiry concerning the start, resulted in no change.
