BRISTOL DANCER chased early, raced three deep on the turn then finished willingly while earning the place. DEREK'S STAR came out some early, challenged for the lead along the inside on the turn and vied for command then was not good enough. PUBLIC SECRET set the pace off the rail, raced between foes on the turn and yielded in the drive. CHIQUIS got out on the turn and lacked a stretch bid. MR WEAVER chased early, raced off the inside and tired. YO KOFFY hung a bit wide into the turn, moved inside on the bend and lacked a bid. BOB'S PLACE was hung a bit wide on the turn and lacked a bid.
