ALL WOUND UP lacked the needed stretch response. THE GREEN WAVE stayed outside and lacked a stretch rally. JAN DID IT lacked a rally. PAPPA DARLING dueled for the early lead and tired. HAY SEPIE lacked a bid. VERDE VALLEY showed little. DON'T PINCH ME saved ground while an early factor then faded.
