GRINCH bumped soundly leaving the gate, saved ground into the far turn, moved out and advanced four wide turning for home then responded well to prevail. KATY KATERS broke outward then in a bit tight briefly into the clubhouse turn, stalked the early issue, moved to the front entering the far turn and drew clear, responded gamely in the drive but was unable to resist the top one. NOTIMETOQUIT never far back, was gaining some late from the outside. MOON FEATHER a bit wide early, lodged a bid outside on the last turn then weakened in the drive. DANCINANDSINGIN saved ground early, raced between foes leaving the backstretch while forwardly placed then tired through the lane. SURREY DOWN lacked a rally. AWANDA unseated the rider while a bit fractious loading, broke out some then failed to menace. DEFINED BORDERS forced a bit wide briefly into the clubhouse turn, raced three deep and was a factor to the drive then gave way. FORBIDDEN FRUIT got out some early, set the early pace and gave way.
