Footnotes

THUNDER BREW advanced outside rounding the final turn, raced three wide into the lane, came in slightly nearing the eighth pole then finished well while drawing clear. FANTASTICO ROBERTO (IRE) well placed early and inside into the far turn, came out slightly nearing the furlong marker then finished willingly. HOUNGUN saved ground into the far turn, moved out for the drive and was gaining late. LETHAL COMBINATION raced near the rail into the far turn, raced in a bit close briefly a furlong out and was steadied slightly then offered a late gain. LIGHTHOUSE SOUND tracked early, moved closer into the far turn and reached the front passing the quarter pole, battled into midstretch and weakened. BANK THE EIGHT outside into the far turn, raced between rivals into the lane, was in close nearing the eighth pole losing momentum then failed to recover. RECKLESS RUNNER pulled early and drew well clear under a snug hold, saved ground and weakened in the drive. A claim of foul by the rider of BANK OF LIGHT against the winner for stretch interference was not allowed.
