FREUD'S HONOUR away a bit awkwardly, moved up early inside and prompted the issue, eased off the inside turning for home and responded gamely to prevail. JACK TAYLOR saved ground to the lane, stayed on the rail and finished gamely. WIDE OPEN ROAD trailed early, eased out in upper stretch then closed well late. RICHIEFROMSHOPRITE never far back and four wide on the turn, lacked the needed late response. DELAWARE'S OWN set the pace and weakened in the drive. ARLO outside on the turn, raced four wide into the lane and lacked the needed bid. CAMP PARTY up close early, raced three wide on the turn between rivals and lacked a stretch bid. JERSEY STORM CAT chased between foes and tired in the drive. D J COMPARI raced wide and lacked a response.
