INKATHA (FR) stalked the pace along the inside, angled out in the second turn and just got the bob under hard right handed urging. ROB 'N GIN set the pace while saving ground, urged hard in the stretch and just missed the bob, very game try. SOVIET LINE (IRE) stalked the pace inside, angled out in late stretch and was gaining on the leaders. STAY SOUND, unhurried, saved ground and finished well, closing. FRISK ME NOW pressed the pace between horses, dropped back the quarter pole and tired in the lane. VETHEUIL, well back, raced four wide and was never in contention. EL MIRASOL was never a factor. LA REINE'S TERMS stalked the early pace, stayed close through the second turn, gave way in the drive.
