GOLDEN GATOR always a factor, advanced outside on the turn and finished willingly while not good enough. AH BOO broke slowly, was steadied some while along the inside entering the turn then lacked the needed late response. AUTO CITY raced outside turning for home and lacked a rally. FORTUNATE BUY raced forwardly placed early and tired. CHOCTAW CHARLIE lacked a rally. BIG KAHUNA broke outward, got out some through the early stages then gave way on the turn. V EIGHT ROCKET vied for the early lead, gave way entering the stretch then faded.
