CHEROKEE CHAMPION never far back and three wide into the lane, finished well and edged clear late. SCARLET BULLETIN came in some early, chased and earned the place late. CHEERLEADING MISS set the pace and weakened through the late stages. COVER MODEL raced off the inside on the turn and lacked the needed response. WILTON TOWN came out some early, saved ground and weakened through the lane. ROSES O'WAR clipped heels soon after the start and stumbled nearly unseating the rider then trailed, A claim of foul by the rider of ROSES O'WAR against SCARLET BULLETIN for interference soon after the start was not allowed.
