STICK TO YOUR GUNS advanced outside on the final turn, was three wide into the stretch and drew clear then held a rival safe under urging. SABOULI saved ground into the far turn, eased three wide into the lane and chased then finished willingly while unable to reach the top one. JEAN'S SURPRISE trailed then finished willingly from the outside. COTTON PICKIN lodged a bid on the final turn, was in the four path entering the stretch and chased then needed more. MISS TAPIT saved ground and lacked a bid. SOUPARION set the early pace, raced a bit rank at intervals and weakened through the lane. ROSIE RED prompted the early issue, moved to the front on the final turn and tired in the drive. RARE EARTH well placed early, lacked a bid then weakened through the stretch.
