MORNING SKY rated the pace two deep, chased Shebelongstoyou through the final turn, lost a bit of ground entering the stretch, recovered well and edged clear from the sixteenth pole. SHEBELONGSTOYOU rated just off the pace and off the rail, edged to the lead inside midway on the final turn, dueled clear into the stretch but yielded to the pacesetter with a sixteenth to go. CLASSIC EXAMPLE broke a step slow, rated off the pace about the three path, bid on the final turn but proved empty in the stretch. BID FOR SILVER rated close to the early pace about the four path then faded on the final turn. PEPPY CANDY stayed with the pace inside, faded after the opening half and was not asked further.
