BOMBAST chased inside, raced between rivals into the stretch, closed steadily and was up late after a long drive. RED VOW vied two wide, took over, dug in gamely and was caught late. ATLANTIC VENTURE stalked outside, bid three wide at the quarter pole and weakened. CAFFE D' ORO stumbled badly at the start, advanced on the turn and rallied mildly. MIPANDO was bumped at the start, vied inside and tired. PRIVATE MARQUE was bumped at the start and did not factor. MR. GRIEVANCE chased outside, came four wide into the stretch and tired. WALT'S WHIZ chased outside, five wide into the lane and tired.
