TRAVELATOR raced outside into the lane, responded well when asked and was along in time. PLATINUM PERFECT moved to the front three deep on the turn, drew well clear into midstretch then was outfinished late. SHE IS RAGING charged the gate just prior to the break then hesitated to be away well behind the field, trailed into upper stretch, was between rivals leaving the furlong grounds and closed well late. GILDED GOLD vied for the early lead between rivals and weakened in the drive. AMBITION UNBRIDLED saved ground early, raced off the inside turning for home and lacked the needed response. CHEZ AUDRA raced in the two path turning for home and lacked a response. DESIRABLE MOMENT vied for the early lead, saved ground and gave way in the drive.
