JEUX DE DANSE close up early inside, awaited room briefly passing the quarter pole, advanced between rivals in upper stretch and reached the front under urging then drew clear and was hand ridden through the final sixteenth. KISSIN WIFE was steadied off heels along the inside nearing the lane, moved out in upper stretch and finished well. MEMORABLE NIGHT saved ground while setting the pace and weakened late. MARKET RESEARCH four wide nearing the top of the lane, was bumped in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. SAGE'S DREAM prompted the early issue and weakened in the drive. COMET ROAD saved ground into the far turn and lacked the needed response. JACQUIE ROSE raced off the inside turning for home and lacked a rally. GLADIATOR GIRL well placed and three wide nearing the lane, bumped with a rival in upper stretch and tired.
