MIKES BET well placed early, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn and reached the front in the stretch then finished steadily and drew out. HARBOR RIDGE saved ground and vied for the lead then was no match late to the top one while narrowly holding the place. NAPKINS never far back and near the rail into the far turn, raced outside into the stretch and just missed the place award. AVE. OF THE PINES vied for the lead, raced between rivals on the backstretch and continued between foes to the lane then gradually weakened. CRAFTY WAYNE moved up three wide on the backstretch and battled for the lead then could not keep pace nearing the quarter pole. UNCOMMON PLEASURE saved ground and lacked a bid. PROMENADES HERO a bit reluctant loading, lunged out and stumbled leaving the gate to be away slowly, raced well off the rail and lacked a rally. DOCTOR DIESEL raced outside into the backstretch and weakened on the final turn.
