Footnotes

FAMILY ALBUM raced unhurriedly through the backstretch toward the inside, made her move around a tiring rival through the final turn, took the lead entering the stretch, was challenged in late stretch and moved away gamely. BLUFFER N' DUFFER raced off the pace, made her bid four wide on the final turn, was in good position in midstretch but faltered through late stretch. WITH THE WORKS came out a step slow, made her bid widest through the final turn, had some mild stretch gain then leveled out late. SHE DID IT HER WAY rated off the pace, made her bid five wide rounding the final turn taking a short lead then drifted inward and finished evenly. CHIP SHOT off the pace toward the inside, made a bid toward the rail on the final turn, took a short brief lead in the upper stretch then weakened off the rail. IRISH TWIRL raced unhurriedly, angled out leaving the final turn and was empty through the stretch. DARBY DANCE drifted slightly outward entering the opening turn, raced close to the top of the stretch then tired. CHOCOLATE CHERRY rated close to the pace, was steadied on the rail entering the final turn then gave way through the stretch.
