WILDCAT LAKE broke out some and set the pace inside, responded well in the drive and edged away then held gamely to the wire. CHARLES RUSSELL saved ground and unhurried early, moved out on the final turn while lodging a bid, lugged in nearing the eighth pole then finished gamely. TIZ CLEAR four wide early then up close outside, chased three wide on the final turn and weakened in the drive. PONZI SCHEME four wide early, moved to the rail on the final turn and lacked the needed rally. NEXT MAY saved ground into the far turn, moved out and lacked a bid. TRIPLE A. RATING prompted the issue and tired through the lane. THE PELOTON failed to menace. E. P. BOMBAY bobbed slightly at the start, pulled early while three wide and weakened on the final turn.
