HUNG JURY bumped at the start, lodged a three wide bid on the turn, pressed then responded to pressure and edged clear late. ARCTIC AIR between rivals early, vied for the lead, raced off the rail into the stretch and held willingly while no match late to the top one. HAT TRICKER just a bit slow at the start and out in the strip midway on the turn, raced in the three path turning for home and finished willingly. NICKY RED up close early between foes, raced along the inside turning for home and weakened in the drive. KNIGHT RATE vied for the early lead from the outside and tired in the drive. FREEDOM EXPRESS chased outside, raced very wide into the stretch and tired. SAL'S BOY raced near the rail on the turn and lacked a bid. BEST JAZZ raced off the inside and lacked the needed bid. SWEET BABY JAMES lacked a rally. FANCY SHAMROCK broke out then saved ground to no avail. KINGDOM OF DAYS pressed early, saved ground and weakened on the turn.
