AMHERST WILDCAT a bit fractious in the gate, saved ground into the far turn, eased out while lodging a bid on the final turn, dueled with FLANK ATTACK then drew clear late. FLANK ATTACK advanced outside leaving the backstretch, drew clear on the last turn and saved ground through the lane then was no match. DREAM DELIVERER between rivals on the backstretch, lost some position into the far turn then was gaining some late outside. RARIFIED trailed early then offered a mild stretch gain. SHADY DEAL close up early from the outside, raced between foes on the final turn and tired. AMERICA'S STORM drew clear on the clubhouse turn, saved ground and had little left entering the stretch. COMMANDING CREEK was steadied slightly on the clubhouse turn, loomed a threat into the far turn then gave way. SKIER hustled early, vied for the lead into the first turn then retreated in the run down the backstretch.
