SATIRA came out some leaving the gate, was rated on the lead to the lane, responded when asked then was under left handed pressure while holding THREE SHOTS safe nearing the wire. THREE SHOTS well placed early, lodged a bid on the final turn, raced just off the inside into the stretch and finished gamely. CABBAGE PATCH GAL tracked early, raced outside into the lane and lacked the needed closing response. WYATT'S WOMEN in a good position early while saving ground, lacked the needed bid then tired through the final furlong. TOUGH GAL trailed early and lacked the needed rally. WILD INDYGO BREW moved up outside on the backstretch, dropped back on the final turn and lost contact into the lane.
