TWO NOTCH ROAD set the pace inside, widened slightly in the lane then held well to the wire. LAUREATE CONDUCTOR tracked early, was asked on the final turn and lost some position turning for home then finished willingly late. MIKOSHI pulled early and a bit rank into the clubhouse turn, saved ground and lodged a two path bid turning for home then needed more late. SCHOPENHAUER between rivals into the far turn, raced four wide into the lane and was gaining late. ROCK IN BAGE (BRZ) just a bit restless in the gate, saved ground to the lane, raced between foes late and needed more. GOLDEN MEXICO (IRE) pulled early and rank, raced in the two path entering the far turn, was along the rail into the stretch and advanced then lacked the needed late response. INTO MY SOUL trailed and along the inside into the lane, lacked the needed rally while in behind some traffic late. ALMORADI (IRE) raced well placed three wide and weakened in the drive. CORONET OF A BARON well placed early, raced three wide into the far turn and weakened.
