FARRAGOTS FOLLIES was bumped at the start, stalked the leader, bid outside on the turn, took over and drew off, driving. SONZUL raced off the inside, moved up three wide on the turn and rallied mildly. CLOSE TO COLTEN raced off the pace, came three wide into the lane and closed belatedly inside. CHANGE FOR GOLD raced off the pace, moved up four wide past the quarter pole and flattened out. SLOVAN gained some ground inside. MY CHARMING PHIL raced inside and failed to respond. PINELANDS PETE set the pace racing three wide, dropped inside entering the turn and gave way. GOLD FOUNTAIN did not factor. MING DYNASTY was bumped at the start, chased inside and faded. A Jockey's Objection by the rider of PINELANDS PETE against the winner was quickly dismissed.
