LAVINIA drew clear on the turn and widened through the lane while being kept to the task. GAELIC BAY trailed early and outside into the lane, finished steadily while clear for the place. SURE CURE saved ground on the turn, eased out slightly in midstretch and lacked a solid response. SILENT PRAYER saved ground while vying for the early lead and weakened in the drive. EVA'SASSY was angled to the rail a furlong out and lacked the needed late response. LASTING LOOK well placed while outside on the turn, tired in the drive. SCOBEGY GIRL broke a bit awkwardly then was headstrong advancing down the backstretch while trying to be rated, moved out into the turn and loomed a threat then tired in the drive. CASE ACCOUNT was through early.
