QUICK TO CHARM saved ground entering the far turn, eased off the inside turning for home and finished gamely to prevail. ALL TOGETHER in a bit tight at the start, raced five wide into the lane and finished gamely. ROMAN TIGER well placed early, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn, lugged in bumping a rival a furlong out then was not good enough. NDONGO never far back and three wide on the final turn, lodged a bid nearing the lane and loomed a threat in midstretch but could not sustain the needed momentum. MASK AND WIG in good position and just off the inside, raced in a bit close briefly in the vicinity of the furlong marker then lacked the needed response. BALLYMOY vied for the early lead, saved ground while showing the way into the lane then weakened in the drive. ASIAGO lacked the needed rally. TOUGH AS TEAK never far back, lacked the needed response. SMILE OF SUCCESS saved ground while well placed and tired through the lane. GIANT MOVE vied for the early lead, prompted the issue thereafter, raced between foes and was bumped while heads apart for command a furlong out then weakened late.
