SKIP TRIAL MISS raced headstrong while four deep down the backstretch, moved to the front on the final turn, continued out in the strip into the stretch then drew off under pressure. HONEYMOON SWEETS never far back, lodged a bid inside on the last turn and earned the place. CASSIDY'S CODE trailed early, raced outside through the lane and finished well. MARLA SUE vied for the early lead between rivals, saved ground rounding the final turn and weakened in the drive. SAXON VIOLINS angled to the rail heading into the clubhouse turn, vied for command to the far turn and tired. MARY NATION prompted the early issue and three deep while between foes on the backstretch, raced outside turning for home and weakened. COURTNEY'S STAR lacked a response.
