SPIRITUAL DRIFT eased out while lodging a bid nearing the top of the lane and responded well in the drive while besting STRODES LANE through the late stages. STRODES LANE lodged a bid outside on the final turn and finished gamely. ROYAL DOVE prompted the early issue, moved to the front on the final turn and drew clear then weakened in the drive. FRANSCAT well placed early, moved up some between rivals nearing the top of the lane, was along the inside entering the stretch and finished willingly while not good enough. SKIP'S SINGER raced just off the inside on the last turn and lacked a rally. KENMARITA (FR) in good position early from the outside, was asked on the final turn and tired in the drive. REMEMBERIN ELEANOR stumbled badly at the start and lacked a rally. PLEASE CALL HOME raced forwardly placed to the far turn and weakened. ONE SMART LADY set the early pace, saved ground and weakened through the lane.
