Footnotes

KATRINA'S PRINCE bobbled at the start and between rivals leaving the backstretch, raced four wide entering the lane and reached the front passing the eighth pole then proved best. LEIPZIG saved ground then broke stride briefly behind a tiring rival entering the far turn, moved out slightly, advanced between foes in upper stretch and battled for the lead then continued on willingly. RUNAWAY JIM up close and saved ground, raced in the two path into the far turn, chased into the lane then was not good enough. SCAVEZZATO broke in some, advanced four wide into the far turn and chased then needed more. PROFESSOR PALMER tracked early, took over entering the far turn and drew clear then weakened in the drive. CLEAR OUT raced four wide into the far turn and lacked the needed bid. DIP MY BEAK well placed early, chased from just off the inside on the final turn and tired in the drive. SIR TAYPOT set the early pace and gave way readily on the final turn.
