SLOANE RANGER prompted early, saved ground on the turn, was brushed entering the lane and again in upper stretch, raced between rivals a furlong out then finished gamely to prevail. ESCROW KID hustled early, drew clear on the turn and dug in gamely through the drive then yielded grudgingly. GOLDDIGGER'S BOY saved ground to the lane, eased out some then was gaining well late from the outside. TRAVELIN MAN was asked to pick it up on the turn, brushed with a rival entering the lane, brushed again with the same foe during the stretch run, chased then was not good enough. CONGRESSIONAL PAGE raced three wide on the turn and lacked a response.
