INDIAN SPELL showed the way to the lane, edged clear and came out inside the eighth pole then just held to the wire. MERRY MEADOW was steadied slightly midway down the backstretch losing position, bid three wide on the turn and finished gamely while just missing. LUCKY RAG DOLL lunged out to be away awkwardly, raced just off the rail turning for home, was brushed a furlong out, moved to the rail late and needed a bit more. COURAGEOUS CALL three wide into the turn, gradually advanced to prompt the issue, brushed with a rival passing the eighth pole, was in a bit tight soon thereafter then yielded. GLITTERAZZI broke a bit slowly, moved up along the inside, saved ground into the turn, was steadied slightly on the bend and tired. PATATUZ trailed and off the inside turning for home, lacked a rally. GOTCHA GOOD prompted early, chased into the turn and weakened. The stewards posted the inquiry sign and the rider of LUCKY RAG DOLL lodged a claim of foul against the winner for stretch interference but no change was made.
