PERFECT OFFICER raced off the pace inside, between rivals midway on the turn, came three wide into the lane and closed gamely outside. NIGHT OFFICER raced off the pace while saving ground, angled out in upper stretch and rallied late outside. VARSITY vied three wide and weakened. FREUDIAN DILEMMA vied inside and weakened. JERSEY BLUE GIANT raced off the pace inside and gained mildly. A P ELVIS was steadied at the start, raced between foes and had no rally. SAINT PETE chased between rivals and tired. SOARING STOCKS raced three wide and did not factor. RUNNING TAP chased three wide and faded.
