S S SKITTLES set the pace, was a bit off the rail turning for home, drifted in some past the furlong marker then dug in determinedly to prevail. GUN POINT raced close up between rivals, was steadied in tight quarters at the seven sixteenths marker and closed gamely on the rail in the stretch. ENGLISH MINISTER had a ground saving trip and rallied on the rail. BIG JOHN B raced between rivals, advanced at the quarter pole, steadied slightly at the furlong marker and rallied between foes. DEAR JOHN raced three wide on both turns and gained mildly outside. JUPITER raced off the pace inside, came three wide into the lane and lacked a rally. SORTANO raced three wide early, pressed the pace and tired. DISCO RHYTHM raced close up inside and tired. SATURDAY'S FOR FUN raced off the rail and did not factor. A Jockey's Objection by the rider of BIG JOHN B against the winner was dismissed.
