IMAGE OF DON up close early inside, lodged a bid along the rail nearing the quarter pole, drew clear in the stretch then was kept to pressure while maintaining a safe advantage. VISION OF NOAH raced just off the rail turning for home and finished gamely while second best. PRIVATE RULES pressed early and outside into the lane, finished steadily and was clear for the show. SIXANDTHREE set the early pace and raced just off the rail on the turn then weakened in the drive. SEWAN INDIAN outside into the turn, chased and tired in the drive. DAPPER TAPPER up close into the turn, was along the inside into the lane and weakened. RAISE THE CODE raced off the inside on the turn and lacked a rally.
