### Footnotes

DIXIE LAUREL'S, never far back, was four wide the quarter pole, gained control the stretch and held sway. NIGHT TALK raced in the middle of the pack, was five wide the turn, rallied. VIA CAVATE vied for the lead inside, had clear control in mid stretch but weakened late. THUNDER WONDER saved ground, blocked in mid stretch, finished well. TIMELY AFFAIR stalked the pace, kept close to mid stretch then flattened out. FREEREPLY, well back, failed to menace. DEVIL'S QUID vied for lead on the pace, gave way in mid stretch. LORETTA ROAD was never a threat. NEATIE tired from off the pace.
