DEVELOPING STORY vied for the early lead, drew clear on the backstretch and showed the way to the lane then responded to urging and held a rival safe. LATEDAY EDITION well placed early, chased turning for home and was no match while holding the place. AURIC GIRL three wide into the far turn, raced between rivals into the lane and needed more late. LATE FOR CLASS along the inside leaving the backstretch and just off the rail turning for home, chased and lacked the needed late response. ZAM SLAM saved ground early while well placed, raced just off the inside into the far turn and weakened in the drive. CATHEDRAL FLYER raced three wide into the far turn and lacked a rally. KATHLEEN'S HALO headstrong early, vied while saving ground and weakened on the final turn.
