STORMANDAPRAYER away alertly, set the pace racing a bit off the inside, shook clear and held well under urging. FEEL THAT FIRE chased the winner and came up second best. PATRIOTIC VIVA chased inside and finished evenly. WYATT'S WOMEN raced inside, came four wide into the lane and gained mildly outside. UNICORN GIRL chased outside, raced between rivals into the stretch and lacked a rally. AD LITEM was bumped at the start, saved ground on the turn and lacked a rally. BANNER ELK LADY chased between rivals and tired. BROADWAY MARQUEE was outrun. SOPCHOPPY was bumped at the start, raced off the rail and gave way.
