CATALITA well placed and outside into the far turn, moved to a narrow advantage on the final turn then finished steadily and edged clear late. BOOM BAH YAY broke inward, stalked the early leader and moved to the front soon after entering the last turn, saved ground and battled through the lane but could not match strides late. SWEEPING ON BYE broke outward, raced along the rail turning for home and offered a mild gain. BARBOURA (FR) trailed early and wide into the stretch, lacked a solid response. FOUR OCLOCK RUBY in tight at the start, raced close up into the far turn, was off the rail on the final turn and weakened. SHE DID IT HER WAY bothered some at the start, set the early pace and had little left turning for home.
