BRANDONS BEACH was well placed on the inside, bid three wide on the far turn, wore down EDGE OF A SHADOW and drew clear under urging. EDGE OF A SHADOW set the pace, dug in gamely when challenged and gave way grudgingly. BUFFALO PAUL pressed the pace and weakened. WORDSMITH raced three wide, bid four wide on the far turn and weakened. THAT'S THE TRUTH raced off the pace and failed to respond. WELL SPOKEN had no rally. MAY EIGHTEENTH raced inside and tired. LETS GET SERIOUS raced between foes and faded.
