Footnotes

SAFELY AT HOME rated close to the pace toward the outside, bid five wide on the turn, dueled clear angling inward midstretch then kept to a drive. REASONTOFLY chased the pace from between horses, was boxed in on the turn, angled out for room making her bid in upper stretch and closed well for place. IS THAT YOU showed no speed in mid track, bid from the top of the stretch and finished well. CATLIKE DANCER kept up in the three path, gave chase on the turn, dueled through the upper stretch, steadied at the eighth pole then leveled out. ELLA BELLA took the lead off the rail rating the pace, dueled inside through the upper stretch then tired the final furlong. HAPPY FACE chased the pace from the outside, lost some ground leaving the quarter pole and finished evenly, widest. CHARLESTON SPRINGS chased the pace from the inside, was steadied lacking room nearing the turn and had nothing left in the stretch. PAISLEY PARK raced toward the outside and never factored. WILL'S GAL was pinched back on the chute and never factored while saving ground.
