FLOWER PATCH settled off the rail, rallied four wide into the stretch, dueled outside and prevailed after a long drive. CAPS LADY raced off the pace inside, rallied three wide into the stretch, dug in between horses and just missed. SWEET M K chased outside, bid three wide passing the quarter pole, gained a short lead and stayed on stubbornly to the finish. JOSEPH JOE raced off the pace, came six wide into the lane and rallied mildly. STRATEGIC SUE saved ground on the turn, angled out and failed to threaten. ONE LUCKY BREW chased inside, made a mild bid on the rail turning for home and tired. SUMMER IN THE CITY set the pace on the inside and faded. MARGIE'S GIRL chased three wide and gave way.
