SEA THE JOY broke alertly and angled over early while clear, showed the way to the lane and widened in midstretch then remained clear to the wire. CHANGEISGONNACOME saved ground to the lane, eased off the inside and finished gamely. TICKET TO SEATTLE saved ground entering the turn, raced in the two path into the lane and was not quite good enough. OUR FANTENE saved ground and advanced in midstretch then lacked the needed closing response. GLACKEN'S MARK went four wide on the turn and lacked the needed rally. DEEP DISH WILDCAT chased from just off the inside and weakened in the drive. BIANCO raced near the inside on the turn and lacked a response. FANLIGHT FANNY chased three wide and tired through the lane. FIVE STAR MAGIC forwardly placed early and just off the inside on the turn, lacked a response and tired in the drive.
