DIDN'T TAKE IT pulled down the backstretch while prompting the issue, moved to the front on the final turn and drove clear through the lane. WARRANT came out briefly early then raced along the inside, moved between rivals turning for home then finished steadily while clear for the place. FORT BOONESBOROUGH lodged a four wide bid on the final turn and chased then was not good enough. MAGIC HARBOR away slowly and a bit rank briefly early, saved ground into the far turn, was swung five wide into the stretch and lacked a late response. MASTER WESLEY hesitated some at the start to be away a bit slowly, saved ground into the far turn, was in the three path into the lane lacked needed stretch bid. OPPY raced along the inside turning for home and lacked a rally. THESSALONIAN bothered some early, saved ground and lodged a three wide bid on the final turn then was steadied in tight between foes at the top of the lane and weakened. TIZNOW A TITAN rated on the early lead, saved ground to the lane and tired in the drive. SOLO APPROACH unseated the rider in the post parade and ran loose briefly, chased to the far turn and weakened. The stewards posted the inquiry sign concerning WARRANT and THESSALONIAN through the early stages and again turning for home prior to declaring the original order of finish official.
