DOUBLE SONG always a factor, advanced along the inside turning for home and reached the front at the top of the stretch, drew clear then maintained a safe edge to the wire. DIABLO'S IMAGE dueled for the lead, raced just off the rail and held on well to the end. C. R. PACE raced between foes, lodged a bid nearing the top of the lane and finished willingly. DELTA QUICK trailed while never far back, raced five wide turning for home and lacked a rally. THE GREAT FLORA lodged a four deep bid on the turn and weakened in the drive. LYNELLEISINJAIL vied for the early lead, raced between rivals turning for home, dropped back and weakened.
