RED GIANT never far back from the outside, raced five wide turning for home, bumped twice with a rival then responded gamely and was along in time. CHALUIWITCANE saved ground into the far turn, raced in the two path entering the lane, lugged in nearing the furlong marker and reached the front then just missed. ENCAUSTIC broke out some, drew clear entering the clubhouse turn, set the pace inside and held well to the wire. WHEELS UP AT NOON vied for the lead inside through the opening stages then settled close up in the two path, raced three wide turning for home and lacked the needed closing response. BRAZENLY BOLD never far back, saved ground and lacked the needed rally. NERVE well placed early, raced four wide and between rivals turning for home, was bumped twice entering the lane then lacked the needed bid.
